Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers pale lavender (H3), single, late July–August.  
Foliage yellow-green tinted with bronze in summer, with  
brick-coloured young shoots in spring and early summer.  
Habit bushy, upright, broad; after 4 years to 30cm tall, and 45cm across (pruned).

Selected clone from mixed seedlings, raised from open-pollinated plants.

Tegel is Swedish for brick and this alludes to the colour of the springtime foliage.
