Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers: mauve (H2; same colour as 'Manitoba'), single; August–September.

Foliage scaly (makes one think of a conifer), orange-yellow in Summer, deepening to red-copper in Winter with orange foliage in heart of plant.

Habit: strongly erect with stiff branches.

Origins: sport on 'Manitoba', found by Albert Bosch in 1999 at nursery.

Differs in colour of foliage and habit, more striking than 'Manitoba'.
