Flowers: double, shell pink, August–October. Foliage: mid-green; creamy yellow spring growth (cream with a very slight pink tint). Habit: a compact mound.

Spring tips are very long, and extremely long lasting similar to 'Japanese White'. Can be used in semi-shade where flowers would not be expected.

Origins: sport on 'County Wicklow' found in 1994 by Ken Hutchins at Oregon Rhododendrons, Corvalis, Oregon. Named by Karla Lortz.
