Flowers: single, pink (H8), August–September.
Foliage: mid-green.
Habit: upright; after 3 years 18ins tall, 12ins across.
"Similar to 'J. H. Hamilton', as far as the foliage color and texture; however, it is more upright and grows taller than 'J. H. Hamilton'."
