Foliage: mid-green.

Habit: upright; after 3 years 18ins tall, 12ins across.

however, it is more upright and grows taller than ‘J. H. Hamilton’.”

Origins: “Wild” seedling, found at the edge of a wooded area by Paul A. Murphy Jr.  
at Waquoit Nursery, Waquoit, Massachusetts, USA, in September 1997.
