Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Calluna vulgaris f. *multibracteata*; blooms much later than other *Calluna*.
Flowers: calyx lobes to 3.5mm long, 2mm broad, ovate; corolla to 3mm long;
lavender (H3); not opening fully, but not bud-flowering; October to February;
stamens 8, not apparently malformed; gynoecium present, not malformed;
flowers solitary at apex of short, multibracteate side-shoots on underside of main stems.
Foliage: dark green.

Habit: bushy, after 2 years 25cm tall, 30cm across.
Origins: a "sport" on 'Chase White' in the Bowens' garden.
