Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers: solitary on side-shoots, buds pink (H8), opening shell-pink (H16); calyx lobes about 3.5mm long, broad; corolla lobes shorter, c.3mm. Foliage: individual leaves minute (less than 1mm long) mid-green, glabrous; very tightly appressed to short and slender side-shoots (about 1cm long, not more than 1mm across), often not branched – the effect is of a mossy shrub; shoots tips paler, yellow-green when young.

> Origins: a seedling selected by Sten-Börje Sörensson in 2006. Named by Sten-Börje Sörensson after his mother: Ally was her second name.
