Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers single, mauve (H2), solitary on short lateral shoots; August–October.  
Young shoots lime-green; mature plants appearing orange-red due to strong red tints  
that develop on sunlit sides of shoots, shaded foliage remaining light green;  
leaves minute, glabrous apart from some hairs on margins and at tip,  
densely clustered on short side shoots.

Habit: spreading, with erect and ascending shoots.

Origins: chance seedling found by Noel Allan,  
in August 2008 at Galloway Heathers, Newton Stewart, Scotland.
