Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers single, lavender; late summer.
Habit originally described by Richard ("Dick") Ide as: "he was scruffy with knots of tightly packed foliage, disorganised, lumpy and obviously a dwarf."

Origins: chance seedling found by Dick Ide,
"A wildling we rescued high on one of [the] Cornish hills ... We carried him home and planted him by the edge of the crazy path among our self sown [*Calluna vulgaris*]. He responded by throwing out some slender new growth. We think he is quite a character."

The name comes from the names Mike and Dick Ide.
