Flowers: heliotrope (H12); corolla small (less than 10mm) with a few scattered gland-tipped hairs; ovary with prominent gland-tipped hairs, very obvious when corolla falls; June-July. Foliage: dark, glossy green; leaves to c. 6mm. Habit: low-growing, compact; after 3 years, 15cm tall, 10cm across. Origins: self-sown seedling in Forest Edge Nursery (Wimborne, Dorset);

parentage unknown but believed to be from D. × *scotica* cultivars on nursery.
