Flowers: white, double; corolla \pm 9mm long, \pm 9mm diameter, broadly urn-shaped; calyx green, sepals to 6mm long, June–October; corolla not shed after flowering Foliage: green throughout the year. Habit: spreading, flowering shoots spreading to erect; to 25cm tall after 4 years, to 35cm across (after 7 years) (not pruned). Origins: deliberately raised seedling from 'Charles Nelson' (pollen parent) × 'White Blum' made in 1998.
