Flowers: pale pink H4 (RHS75D) lilac to H16 (RHS65C) shell pink. Foliage: mid-green; young shoots discoloured; leaves in whorls of 4. Habit: to 1m tall after 5 years; habit upright, sparse. Origins: seedling raised in 2000 by Kurt Kramer, Edewecht, Germany. Named by Allen Hall.
