Flowers numerous, in clusters of 2–4 at ends of leafy shoots; corolla to 2cm long, tubular, white, translucent, 4-lobed, minutely hirsute on exterior; sepals 4, pale green, with gland-tipped marginal hairs; ovary pale green, glabrous, squat, 6-lobed, emarginate; style erect, recessed in top of ovary, glabrous, style-apex capitate, not emergent; stamens 8, included; filaments slender, erect; anthers dark, minute (±1.2mm long), with slender, linear appendages (±0.7mm long). Foliage mid-green; leaves in whorls of 4, linear, ±7mm long, with sparse, minute hairs. Habit: erect, to 0.7m in 2 years from cuttings.

Origins: chance seedling which appeared among seedlings grown from the seed supplied by Silverhill Seeds from South Africa. This plant first flowered in February 2000 at Shiota Heath Garden, Hamamatsu, Japan.
