Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers: corolla white, urceolate; to 5.3mm long; to 2.9mm wide; calyx white;
November/December–March/April; anthers without awns.

Foliage: green.

Habit: low shrub; after 2 years approx. 15cm tall, approx. 30 cm across.
Origins: only surviving seedling (original clone) of a deliberately created hybrid
between *E. lusitanica* ‘George Hunt’ pollinated by *E. erigena*
(seedling from ‘Golden Lady’ (EEGLS 87.69));
hand-pollinated; seed taken 1996.

Named by Barry Sellers; from “*lusi-*” and “*-gena*”.

At the time of registration no validly published binomial existed for this hybrid:
the proposed specific epithet is “*londinensis*”.
