Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Foliage golden-yellow in winter, turning yellow in summer;
leaves in whorls of 3, to 10mm long, about 1mm across, tapering towards apex.
Flowers numerous, greenish, corolla 2mm long; style-end *c.* 1mm diameter.

Origins: found on by a levada in Madeira by David Edge;
propagated and introduced by Forest Edge Nurseries and
shown at Gardener’s World Live, Birmingham, June 2010.
