Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers absent; replaced by dark ruby (H5; RHSCC Red 183C) bud-like cluster of bracts having the shape and texture of sepals.

Foliage green.

Habit fairly open shrub.

Origins: noticed on Ockham Common, Surrey, about 2004 by James Adler; subsequently (2006) propagated at RHS Garden, Wisley; introduced by Forest Edge Nursery, Wimborne, Dorset.
